3 skeins Purple Fusion

US9 (5.5mm) straight

## **Stitches Used (Abbreviations):**

Cast On (CO)

Bind Off (BO)

Knit (k)

Purl (p)

Slip Slip Knit (ssk)

Yarn Over (yo)

Right Side (RS)

Wrong Side (WS)

Knit 2 together (k2tog) Stitches (sts)

Seed Stitch

Grapevine Stitch

## **Gauge - Before Washing & Blocking:**

Work 135 stitches in pattern, for 4 inches.

Piece should measure 29.5 inches across.

Needle size can be changed to obtain recommended gauge.

### **Odd Number Stitches - Seed Stitch:**

Row 1: \*Knit 1, purl 1. Repeat from \* across

Row 2: \*knit 1, purl 1. Repeat from \* across

### **Pattern (adapted Grapevine Stitch):**

**Row 1:** k1, p1, k1, \* k2tog, k1, yo, k1, ssk, k2; rep from \* to the last 4 sts, k2, p1, k1. (119 sts)

**Row 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12:** k1, p1, purl to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

**Row 3:** k1, p1, \* k2tog, k1, (yo, k1) twice, ssk; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k3, p1, k1. (119 sts)

**Row 5:** k1, p1, k2, \* yo, k3, yo, k1, ssk, k1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k1, p1, k1. (135 sts)

**Row 7:** k1, p1, k4, \* k2tog, k1, yo, k1, ssk, k2; rep from \* to the last 9 sts, k2tog, k1, yo, k1, ssk, k1, p1, k1. (119 sts)

**Row 9:** k1, p1, k3, \* k2tog, k1, (yo, k1) twice, ssk; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p1, k1. (119 sts)

**Row 11:** k1, p1, k2, \* k2tog, k1, yo, k3, yo, k1; rep from \* to the last 3 sts, k1, p1, k1. (135 sts)

**\*\*Insert a lifeline after working row 12. This will really help if a mistake is made.\*\***

### **Instructions:**

- a) Cable Cast On 135 sts.
- b) Row 1 & row 2: Work seed stitch.
- c) Work pattern until piece measures approximately 26.5 inches ending with row 12 of pattern. This is approximately 9 repeats of the pattern.
- d) Work row 1 of seed stitch (this will be a RS row).
- e) Work row 2 of seed stitch (this will be a WS row).
- f) Work row 1 of seed stitch while binding off loosely (this will be a RS row).
- g) Weave in loose ends.
- h) Block as desired.
