Tapestry Needle, Sewing Needle +
50" (127cm) Sewing Thread
(Black), 350 Size 10 Round Seed
Beads (Black), 15 Crystal Bicone
Beads (3mm, Silver) **Make sure
all beads can be threaded onto
the sewing thread using the
sewing needle.

Stitches Used (Abbreviations):

Cast On (CO)	Knit (k)
Bind Off (BO)	Purl (p)
Right Side (RS)	Wrong Side (WS)

Pattern (stockinette stitch):

Row 1: knit
Row 2: purl

Gauge - Before Washing & Blocking:
26.6 stitches = 4" (10cm)

Instructions:

- Cable Cast On 50 stitches.
- Repeat **Rows 1 and 2**, until piece measures 9¾" (24.77cm) from cast on edge, ending on a WS row.
- BO Loosely (RS), cut 20" (50.8cm) tail.
- Lay piece flat with knit side (RS) facing you, bind off edge on top and cast on edge at bottom.
- Fold piece into 2, side to side. (knit sides facing each other. You now see the purl side (WS).
- Whipstitch the sides and bottom.
- Weave in loose ends.
- Block as desired.
- Attach seed beads and crystals per instructions.

Attaching seed beads:

- 1) Cut sewing thread into 2 equal lengths.
- 2) Thread both strands onto sewing needle.
- 3) Tie a knot at one end.
- 4) On the clutch, identify on the purl side, the whipstitch seam at the open edge.
- 5) Using needle and thread, make a loop into the whipstitch seam, close to the opening edge – this is to anchor the thread.
- 6) Turn the clutch inside out or outside in, so that the knit side is facing you and the purl side is the inside clutch. Beads will be attached with knit side facing you.
- 7) String about 20 seed beads.
- 8) Change to tapestry needle.
- 9) Gently weave tapestry needle in and out of the 'V's created on the bind off edge.
- 10) Make sure tapestry needle moves between yarn strands and not into yarn strands or the beads will get caught.
- 11) Gently slide the beads as you weave the tapestry needle to make sure there is no gap on the sewing thread.
- 12) Change back to sewing needle and thread 20 more beads.
- 13) Repeat steps (8) through (12) until entire open edge is beaded.
- 14) To end, with sewing needle, make a loop into the whipstitch seam. Cut excess thread.

Attaching crystals:

Crystals will be attached at the top open edge, in the middle (knit side facing you).

- 1) Thread both remainder strands onto sewing needle.
- 2) Tie a knot at one end.
- 3) Make a loop into the yarn at the edge – small loop so it is hardly visible.
- 4) Thread all crystals.
- 5) Find a point on the clutch edge that will give a nice 'curve' to the strand of crystals.
- 6) Make a small loop at that point, tie a knot, weave into a few strands of yarn.
- 7) Cut thread.



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
