Knotted Friendship Bracelet Tutorial

Make this gorgeous bracelet using overhand knots, in under 2 hours!

Individual preference

Thread (2 colors)

Crochet Thread
(Red Heart, KnitPicks Curio)
OR

Embroidery Floss (DMC)
(2 strands of each color)

Notions

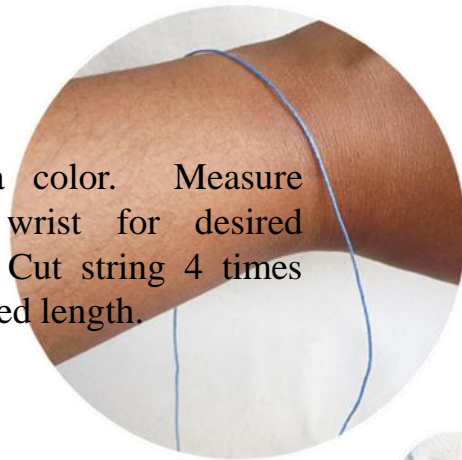
Scissors
Translucent Scotch Tape
Clip Board



Steps:

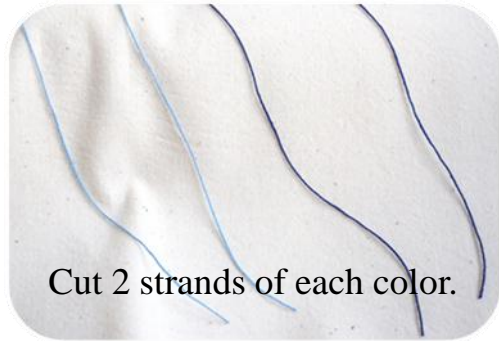
1

Select a color. Measure around wrist for desired length. Cut string 4 times the desired length.



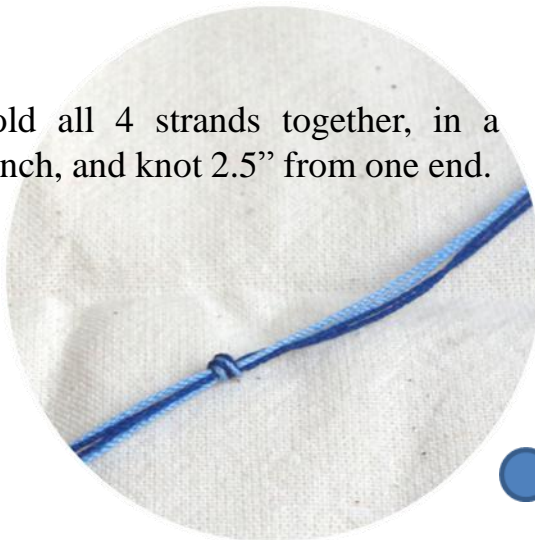
2

Cut 2 strands of each color.

Hold all 4 strands together, in a bunch, and knot 2.5" from one end.



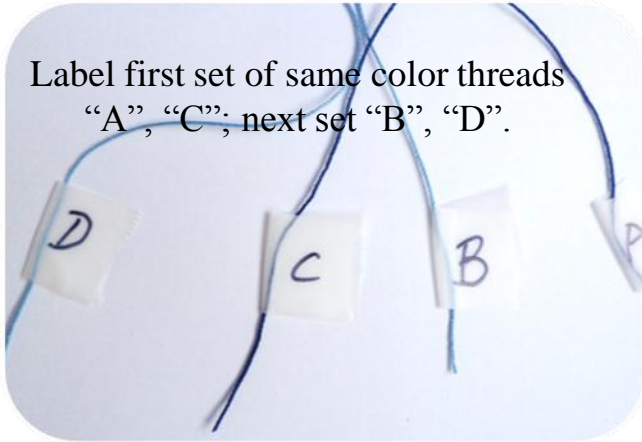

Tie knotted end to the clipboard.



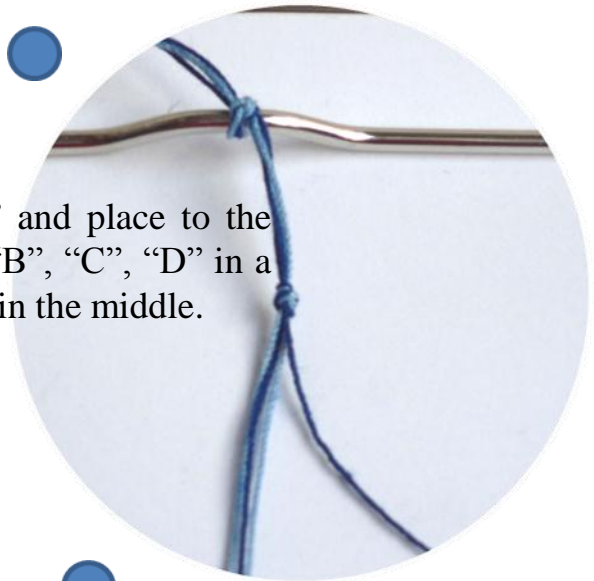
Label first set of same color threads
“A”, “C”; next set “B”, “D”.

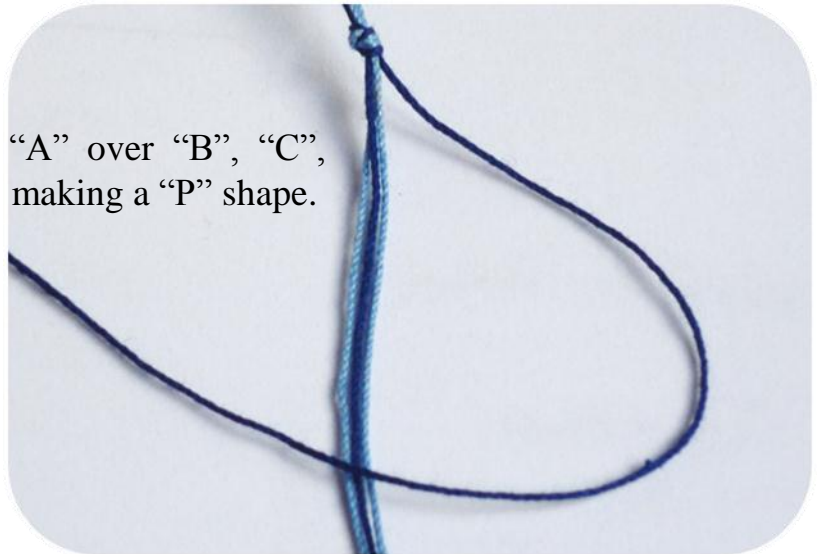

Separate “A” and place to the right. Hold “B”, “C”, “D” in a bunch; place in the middle.



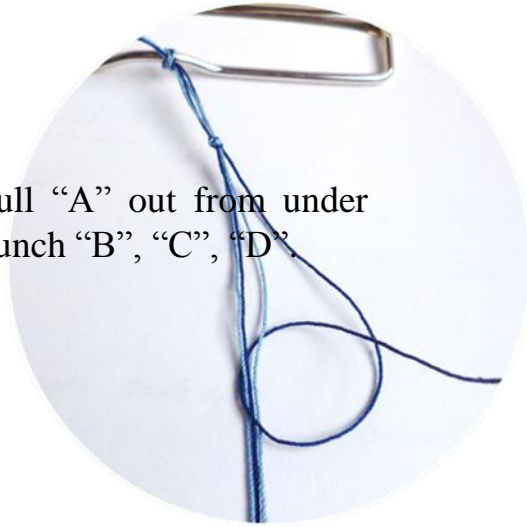

Lay “A” over “B”, “C”, “D”, making a “P” shape.

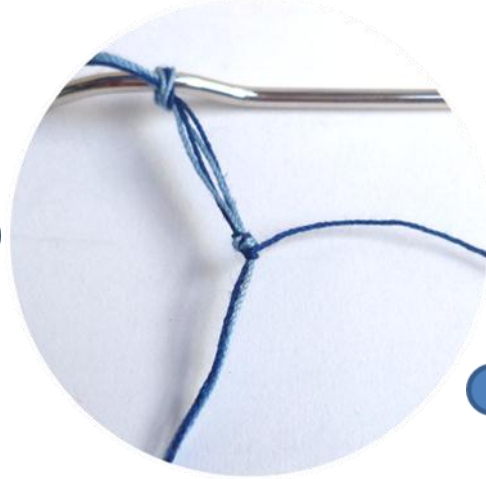
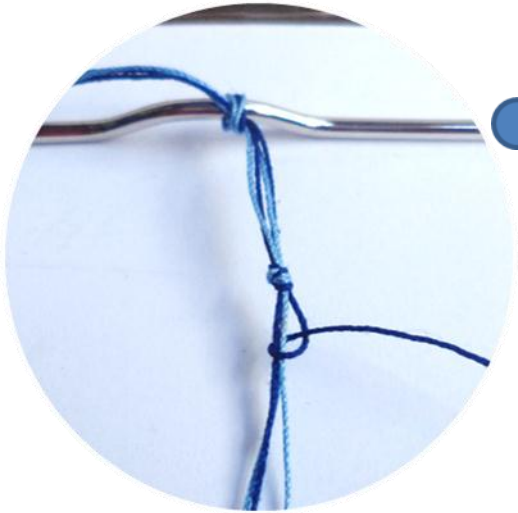

Pull “A” out from under bunch “B”, “C”, “D”.



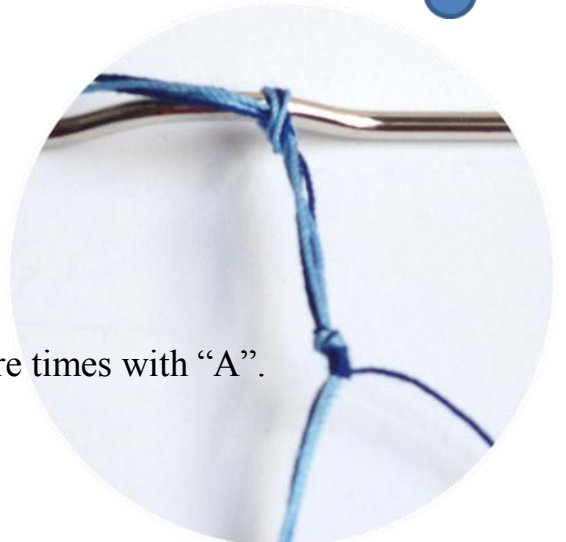
Pull “A” tight and push it upwards towards the knot, so that there are no gaps.

Repeat 3 more times with “A”.



● Repeat steps 6 through 10 with “B”.

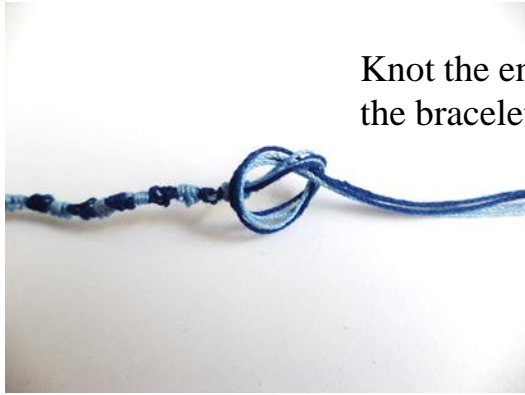

- Repeat steps 6 through 10 with “C” and “D”.
- Repeat color sequence “A”, “B”, “C”, “D” until you reach desired length.



Knot the end of the bracelet.

Trim the ends of the bracelet so that they are equal.
