100% Roving Silk

US5 (3.75mm) straight

Notions

Tapestry Needle

An Exclusive design for Mint Yarns, using just 1 skein of luxurious silk yarn! Gradient shades create a subtle 'Z' effect on the scarf.

Stitches Used (Abbreviations):

Cast On (CO) Knit (k)

Yarn Over (YO) Purl (p)

Bind Off (BO) Knit 2 together (k2tog)

Right Side (RS) Wrong Side (WS)

Notes: Gauge and swatching are not required for this project.

^ Instead of knitting into the stitch (above the YO) on row 6, knit into the hole caused by the YO in row 5 (i.e. pull yarn through the hole) but drop the stitch on row 6.

Instructions:

Cast On 33 stitches (using cable cast on method).

Rows 1 - 4: Knit (ending on a WS row).

Row 5: Knit2, *(YO, k2tog)* repeat until 1 stitch remains, knit1.

Row 6: Knit.

Row 7: Knit (when you get to the YO hole from row 5, knit directly into the YO hole of row 5 but drop the stitch that is sitting on row 6)^.

Rows 8: Knit.

Repeat Rows 5 through 8 until scarf measures 38 inches, ending on a WS row (approximately 74 repeats).

Purl the RS row, Knit the WS row.

BO Loosely (RS), Weave in loose ends.

Blocking is optional.
